Chapter 1: How You Approach Life and How You Appear To Others

Sun Opposition Mars:

Chapter 3: Mental Interests and Abilities

Mercury in Scorpio:

Mercury Opposition Pluto:

You have a very suspicious, even paranoid, side. You mind is penetrating and deep and you have an aptitude for research, investigative reporting, or private investigation. You are drawn to anything secret, hidden, or mysterious, and may pursue esoteric or occult studies. You are also a forceful and convincing speaker or writer, with the ability to influence peoples' thinking by the sheer power of your conviction.

Chapter 4: Emotions: Moods, Feelings, Romance

Moon in Aquarius:

Chapter 5: Drive and Ambition: How You Achieve Your Goals

Mars in Aries:

Mars Opposition Jupiter:

No matter how much you accomplish, you never seem to be completely satisfied. You always feel you can do more, and set your sights on another goal. You like to keep stretching your limits, to see how far you can go. Chapter 6: Other Influences

Jupiter in Libra:

Saturn Opposition Neptune:
